



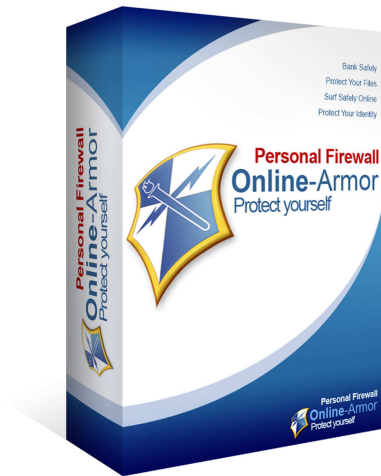

German version of the Online Armor Firewall available soon

Online Armor Firewall 3.0: Try it for free

The English version of Online Armor Firewall 3.0 is currently available for downloading from the newly created German Tall Emu homepage (<http://www.tallemu.de/>) (13.1 MB). The program runs under Windows 2000, XP and Vista. A free test version allows you to try out the firewall on your own computer. The full version costs 29.95 Euros, including updates for 1 year, and a family license for up to three PCs costs only 49.95 Euros.

The homepage also offers a bundle containing the Online Armor Personal Firewall Free and a-squared Free. Both programs can be used free of charge by private users and help to set up a simple but effective firewall and scanner for uncovering any damaging software that may have already penetrated the system.

Christian Mairoll: "Online Armor Firewall has been somewhat of a secret tip in the security forums: the program has now developed into serious competition for the heavyweights in this sector. We are keen to read the first comments and assessments of the German technical press. The localized German version 3.1 will be available soon."
